THIS COURT ORDERS AND DECLARES that:


1. the Sixth Report of the Receiver dated May 13, 2011 (the "Sixth Report"), and the conduct of the Receiver as particularised therein, is hereby approved;

AND THIS COURT ORDERS THAT:

2. the Receiver pay the sum of \$1,500,000.00 to CIBC Mellon Trust Company in partial satisfaction of the security held by the Note Holders (as defined in the Sixth Report) in respect of assets being administered by the Receiver;
3. Davis LLP pay to NC Power Systems Company, or its counsel, the sum of \$55,606.00 from the net proceeds (the "Proceeds") of the Gator Tug (as defined in the Sixth Report) as at the date of the Sixth Report plus a per diem of \$19.26 thereafter in complete satisfaction of its claims against the Gator Tug and the Proceeds;
4. following the payment referenced above, Davis LLP shall remit all of the remaining Proceeds to the Receiver to be disbursed in accordance with further orders of this Court; and
5. approval of this Order by counsel appearing, other than counsel for the Receiver, is hereby dispensed with.
