- 3. after the payment of the fees and disbursements of the Receiver as herein approved, the Receiver shall pay all funds remaining in its hands to 2242229 Ontario Inc.;
- 4. upon payment of the amounts set out in paragraph 3 hereof and upon the Receiver filing a Certificate certifying that it has completed the remaining outstanding activities described in the Report, if any, the Receiver shall be discharged as Receiver of the assets, undertaking and property of 682202 B.C. Ltd., provided notwithstanding its discharged herein:
 - (a) the Receiver shall remain Receiver for the performance of incidental duties as may be required to complete the administration of the receivership herein; and
 - (b) the Receiver shall continue to have the benefit of the provisions of all Orders made in this proceeding, including all approvals, protections and stays of proceedings in favour of Alvarez & Marsal Canada Inc. in its capacity as Receiver.
- 5. Alvarez & Marsal Canada Inc. is hereby released and discharged from any and all liability that Alvarez & Marsal Canada Inc. now has or may hereafter have by reason of or in any way arising out of the acts or omissions of Alvarez & Marsal Canada Inc. while acting in its capacity as Receiver herein.
