The Monitor will make a motion before the Honourable Madam Justice Spivak on Wednesday, February 5, 2014 at 10:00 a.m., or as soon after that time as the motion can be heard, at the Law Courts Building, 408 York Avenue, Winnipeg, Manitoba.

THE MOTION IS FOR:

- 1. An order, substantially in the form attached hereto as Appendix "1":
 - (a) abridging the time for and validating service of the Notice of Motion and supporting materials such that the motion is properly returnable on February 5, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. and dispensing with further service thereof;
 - (b) extending the stay period ("Stay Period") as defined in paragraph 30 of the Order of the Honourable Madam Justice Spivak made February 22,
 2012 (the "Initial Order") until May 30, 2014;
 - (c) approving the Fourteenth Report of the Monitor dated January 29, 2014 (the "Fourteenth Report") and the activities described therein; and

(d) granting such further and other relief as this Honourable Court may deem just.

THE GROUNDS FOR THE MOTION ARE:

- 2. Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act, R.S.C. 1985, c.C-36, as amended (the "CCAA") ss. 11 and 11.02 and the inherent and equitable jurisdiction of this Court.
- 3. Queen's Bench Rules 2.03, 3.02(1), 16.04, 16.08, 37.07(1), and 37.08(2).

Background

- 4. Capitalized terms not defined herein shall have the meaning ascribed to them in the Fourteenth Report.
- 5. On February 22, 2012, the Court granted protection to the Applicants (including Glacier Valley Ice Company, L.P. (California)) in the Initial Order pursuant to the CCAA.
- 6. The Applicants completed a Sale and Investor Solicitation Process as set out in the Initial Order and entered into an Asset Purchase Agreement (as amended, the "APA"), made as of June 7, 2012.
- 7. On June 21, 2012, the Court granted an order, among other things, approving the transaction provided for in the APA (the "Sale Transaction").
- 8. The Sale Transaction closed on July 27, 2012. After making required payments, and taking into account other receipts and disbursements, the Monitor is

currently holding approximately US\$118.1 million in trust pending further Order of the Court.

- 9. On September 5, 2012, this Honourable Court issued the Claims Procedure Order that approved the Claims Process.
- 10. On March 7, 2013, this Honourable Court issued an Order appointing Claims Officers to adjudicate disputed Claims.

Validating Service

11. The service effected and notice provided has been sufficient to bring these proceedings to the attention of the recipients and it is appropriate in the circumstances for this Honourable Court to validate service and proceed with the hearing for the relief requested.

Extending the Stay Period

- 12. The Monitor is requesting an extension of the Stay Period to May 30, 2014.
- 13. The Monitor is of the view that the Applicants have acted and continue to act in good faith and with due diligence.
- 14. The Monitor believes that an extension of the Stay Period until May 30, 2014 is appropriate, as it will allow additional time for the Monitor, in consultation with the Applicants, to continue to work towards a resolution of the remaining unresolved Claims filed in the Claims Process.

15. The proposed Stay extension date of May 30, 2014 is being requested based on the expected timeline to seek final U.S. Court approval for the Indirect Purchaser Claim settlement and to present a Plan of Arrangement to the Court.

Approving the Fourteenth Report and the Monitor's Activities

- 16. In accordance with the practice that has developed, the stakeholders have had a reasonable opportunity to review and take issue with the Fourteenth Report and the activities described therein and, absent any significant objection, the Fourteenth Report should be approved by this Honourable Court.
- 17. Such further and other grounds as counsel may advise and this Honourable Court may permit.
