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ENDORSEMENT OF JUSTICE CONWAY:

All defined terms used herein shall, unless otherwise defined, have the meanings ascribed to them in the Foreign Representative's Motion Records for today's hearing.

The Foreign Representative brings two recognition motions today under Part IV of the CCAA. One is for recognition of the Settlement Stipulation Order. That order has not been entered by the U.S. Bankruptcy Court yet. Counsel have agreed to adjourn that motion for the time being.

The second motion is for recognition of the Eagle Sale Order and the Confirmation Order and for termination of the CCAA proceedings. The motion is unopposed. The Information Officer recommends the relief sought.

I am prepared to grant the order recognizing the Eagle Sale Order. However, I am not prepared to grant the order recognizing the Confirmation Order and terminating the CCAA Proceedings today. There is a comeback hearing before the U.S. Bankruptcy Court on October 26, 2022 due to some service issues on the motion before that court. Although counsel do not anticipate that there will be any issue with the Confirmation Order, I want to wait until after the October 26 hearing to be certain that the Confirmation Order is in final form. I have therefore adjourned that part of the motion to <u>October 27, 2022 at 10 a.m. before me for 30 minutes</u> (confirmed with the CL office).

Counsel have now revised the draft recognition order to apply only to recognition of the Eagle Sale Order. It is satisfactory to me and I have signed and attached it to this endorsement. This order is effective from today's date and is enforceable without the need for entry and filing.

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
