**Conway J. Endorsement**

This is a further motion for recognition of two orders granted by the U.S. Bankruptcy Court: a lease rejection order and a de minimis asset sales order. The motion is unopposed. In particular, the lease rejection order will apply to one lease in Canada, in Montreal, and the landlord's counsel advised that they are not opposing the order. The Information Officer recommends the recognition of the orders as being necessary to the Debtors' continued business operations and to advance the restructuring proceedings, all as set out in the Second Supplement to the First Report.
