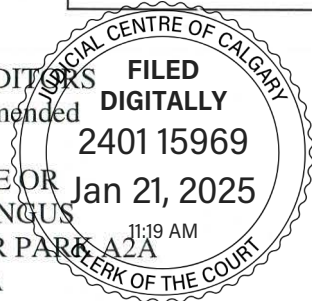


5. In the event an interested party wishes to unseal the contents of Confidential Exhibit “A” to the Third Picard Affidavit, such interested party may bring an application to Court in the
