WHEREAS:

- A. On September 26, 2022, each of Sugarbud Craft Growers Corp. ("SCGC"), Trichome Holdings Corp. ("THC") and 1800905 Alberta Ltd. ("Opco" together with SCGC and THC, collectively "Sugarbud") flied a Notice of Intention to Make a Proposal (the "NOI") pursuant to section 50.4(1) of the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act* with the Office of the Superintendent of Bankruptcy (the "NOI Proceedings") and Alvarez & Marsal Canada Inc. ("A&M") was appointed as the Proposal Trustee of each of the Sugarbud entities.
- B. On October 14, 2022, Sugarbud continued the NOI Proceedings into proceedings (the "CCAA Proceedings") under the Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act (as amended, the "CCAA") pursuant to an initial order (the "Initial Order") under the CCAA and, on the same date, also

obtained an Amended and Restated Initial Order (the "**ARIO**") and A&M was appointed as monitor of Sugarbud (A&M in such capacity, the "**Monitor**").

C. Pursuant to paragraph 7 of the Order of the Justice C. Feasby made in these CCAA Proceedings on May 9, 2023 (the **"CCAA Termination Order"**), the Monitor shall be discharged and the CCAA Proceedings shall be terminated upon the Monitor filing this Monitor's Termination Certificate with the Court.
