### PARTICULARS OF APPLICATION

- The applicant seeks the following remedy or order: That the Notice of Revision or Disallowance provided by Alvarez & Marshal Canada Inc. on February 20<sup>th</sup>, 2020 revising the S3 Wireform Claim from \$22,032.37 to \$0 be overturned, and an Order be made that Morris Inc pay S3 Wireform \$17,858.62 and accept delivery of its equipment.
- 2. In the alternative an Order that Morris Industries LTD. Pay damages based on refusal to accept shipment from S3 Manufacturing in the amount of \$15,787.31.
- 3. The applicant's grounds for making this application are the court's broad general powers under the *Act* in s. 11, and paragraph 18 of the Honourable Mr. Justice R.S. Smith's Claims Process Order of January 16<sup>th</sup>, 2020 as extended by the Monitor and pursuant to Rule 6-5 of the QB Rules.

# 4. The Material Facts are:

- a. On August 12th, 2019 Morris Industries provided a Purchase Order to S3 Wireform.
- b. The Order was completed by September 4<sup>th</sup>, 2019, and was ready for the scheduled delivery date.
- c. The schedule delivery date was postponed pending receipt of payment from Morris.
- d. Morris provided various promises about creating a payment plan and strategy between September of 2019 and March of 2020.
- e. Morris repeatedly requested that the materials be held on to, as they would be required for ongoing operations.
- f. The shipment was partially completed via payment from Morris in the amount of \$4,173.75 for shipment of some of the product ordered. This shipment was complete and finalized.
- g. Delivery of the remainder of the order can occur on the court's determination.
- h. S3 completed and submitted a Proof of Claim. It was disallowed on the basis that Morris does not intend to purchase the items.
- 5. In support of this application, the applicant relies on the following material or evidence:
  - a. The Affidavit of Joe Gallant, sworn March 24th, 2020
  - b. Any other material counsel may suggest and the court may allow.
