EXTENSION OF STAY PERIOD

1. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the stay period as referred to in the Amended and Restated Initial Order of Chief Justice Morawetz dated December 23, 2019 is extended until ~~February 25~~, 2020 in respect of the Applicants and the Non-Applicant Stay Parties.

MONITOR'S ACTIVITIES

2. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the Monitor's activities, as set out in the First Report, be and are hereby approved; provided, however, that only the Monitor, in its personal capacity and only with respect to its own personal liability, shall be entitled to rely upon or utilize in any way such approval.

3. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the unredacted BMO Engagement Letter (as defined in the Sellers Comeback Affidavit) is hereby sealed pending further Order of the Court.

4. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the affidavit of Edward Sellers sworn January 21, 2020 and the exhibits thereto are hereby sealed pending further Order of the Court.

5. **THIS COURT HEREBY REQUESTS** the aid and recognition of any court, tribunal, regulatory or administrative body having jurisdiction in Canada, Armenia, the Bailiwick of Jersey, the United Kingdom, or the United States to give effect to this Order and to assist the Applicants, the Monitor and their respective agents in carrying out the terms of this Order. All courts, tribunals, regulatory and administrative bodies are hereby respectfully requested to make such orders and to provide such assistance to the Applicants and to the Monitor, as an officer of this Court, as may be necessary or desirable to give effect to this Order, to grant representative status to the Monitor in any foreign proceeding, or to assist the Applicants and the Monitor and their respective agents in carrying out the terms of this Order.
