(the "Monitor"), and upon hearing from counsel on behalf of other parties participating, and upon reading the Notice of Application dated the 26th day of May, 2020, the Sixth Report of the Monitor dated May 26, 2020 (the "Sixth Report"), the Confidential Appendix to the Sixth Report of the Monitor dated May 26, 2020 (the "Confidential Appendix"), and the Draft Order (collectively, the "Application Materials"), all filed with proof of service; and upon reading the pleadings and proceedings herein;

THE COURT ORDERS:

- 1. The term of the Amended and Restated Initial Order granted by the Honourable Mr. Justice R.S. Smith in these proceedings on January 16, 2020 (the "ARI Order"), and the stay of proceedings provided for thereunder, shall be and are hereby extended from 11:59 p.m. on May 29, 2020 to 11:59 p.m. on July 3, 2020.
- 2. All activities, actions, conduct and proposed courses of action of the Monitor (collectively, the "Actions of the Monitor") from May 8, 2020 through to and including May 29, 2020 in relation to the discharge of its duties and mandate as Monitor pursuant to the various Orders of the Court of Queen's Bench for Saskatchewan in these proceedings, as such Actions of the Monitor are more particularly described in the Sixth Report, shall be and are hereby approved and confirmed.
- 3. The Confidential Appendix shall be kept sealed and confidential and shall not form part of the public record, but rather shall be placed, kept separate and apart from all other contents of the Court file, in a sealed envelope which shall bear a notice which sets out the title of these proceedings and a statement that the contents are subject to a sealing order and shall only be opened upon further order of the Court.
